Cruise To MBC By Boat:

- Enter LaPlaisance Creek from the start (R"2") of the well marked entrance channel. Follow the bouys from the lake to the start of LaPlaisance Creek. Use chart 14846_14 for a more detailed view.
- Follow LaPlaisance Creek around until you arrive at MBC.
- Hail VHF Channel 69 or 9 for location of guest dockage. (Monroe Boat Club monitors VHF Channel 16 & 69.)

Cruise To MBC By Car:

- Monroe Boat Club is located at 7932 N Harbor Drive (Bolles Harbor Drive) in Monroe, MI
- Take Interstate 75 to exit 11. From the North turn left onto Laplaisance Rd, from the South turn right onto Laplaisance Rd. Follow Laplaisance Rd. east until the road forks at the yield sign, stay left as the road now becomes Lake St.
- Continue a short distance and turn left onto Bridge Dr, follow the road around to the right until it becomes N Harbor Dr, you will now be able to see MBC on the left.

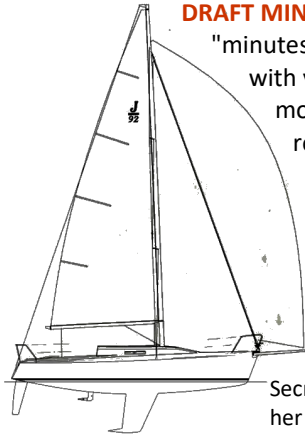

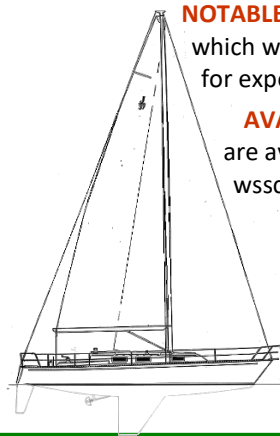

IMPORTANT HEADS-UP FROM PC DOUG: "Canadian Customs. If one does not properly check into Canadian Customs, you can be subjected to a fine of not less than \$1,000."



DO YOU HAVE YOUR DTOPS DECAL? Boats of length 30' or more need a DTOPS decal to return to the U.S. This number as well as a Trusted Traveler number (may not be required for boaters) should be entered into CBP Roam as well as passport numbers.

CBP ROAM REQUIRED: US requires the use of CBP Roam.

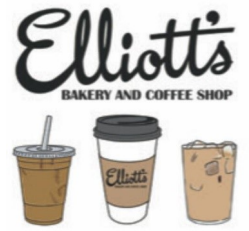

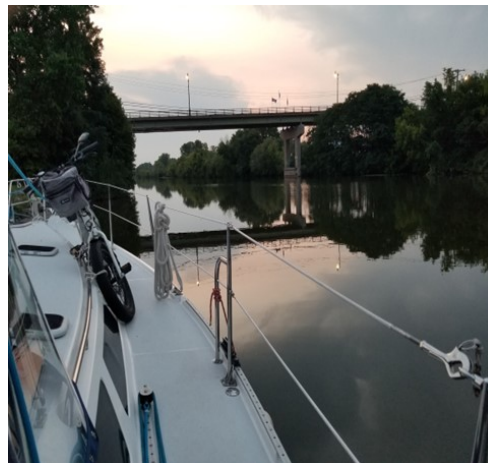


August After-Meeting Program: "WINDQUEST GREAT ADVENTURE" with PC KATHY AND PC DOUG HOWE

I-YLA General Spring Meeting 2024

Called to order: 15:35 pm

Invocation & Pledge of Allegiance

Role Call of Commodores and Special Guests

Minutes -R/A

Nominating Committee Elections: 10 nominations but five will be elected. Must be from different clubs and they are not able to run for office in the next year. If members of multiple clubs they must designate which club they are representing. Candidates must be present and agree to serve.

Advisory Committee: No report

Executive Secretary: 135 clubs with all paid. Insurances are up to date. Let her know of any clubs who should be invited to join.

Treasurer: All bills paid and records transferred. New budget approved for next year.

ILYA Trustee: Cindy Johnson Mintus was appointed to replace the recently deceased Al Ashley.

Delegates:

USSA: Recent conference had 400 participants with multiple breakout sessions. Nation was divided into 9 regions. All of ILYA falls into the same region of #7. One big goal is to expand the future generation of sailors. Special emphasis is placed on Olympics. Jamie Jones of Hoover Sailing club won the volunteer award.

YRU of Great Lakes: No Report

National Boating Federation: Ed Payne remained as representative. Big movement to get derelict boats out of the water before they sink. May charge for removal if not volunteer to remove.

Boating Assoc. of Ohio: Lake Erie has been awarded \$53,000,050 in federal funds for parks and watercraft projects. Much of the original money is still available. Clubs should check the ODNR website for available grants.

Yachtsman Fund: Yachtsman Fund still in good standing. Typical grants were awarded. It was a big year for Jrs Instructional as well as Jr. Sail funding. Extra funds were awarded to youth racing. Funding was also used to send women to the national invitational.

Code of Regulations: will put forward revised coded in Fall. Will be on the website for three weeks before meeting. Working on guidelines for new candidates to become officers of the organization. Example: Yachtsman Fund was a 9-year commitment. Now set at 3 years to keep things moving forward and encourage more willing volunteers to participate.

Admiralty: No Report

Sponsorship: \$1500 grant from Lake Erie Shores. They are developing a one page note with a Q code to help get sponsorship information out.

Yearbook: in progress.

I-LYA Historian: Reviewed past secretaries. Also identified individual who participated for 55 years. Please contact historian before any club throws out materials. Club has all but 20 of the annual yearbooks.

Perpetual and Memorial Trophies: -Thanks to Bob Lang for updating bases and cleaning up certain trophies.

Island Liaison: Due to death of Al Ashley having to recreate the signed copies of the contracts. Still need three members and to replace Al.

Powerboat: Dates July 23 to 28. Coincides with unofficial Christmas in July so extra security is being hired for the docks. Registration will open on May 6. Most activities are ready to go. Many new changes. Dock rates have increased to \$2.25 per foot. Social fees from \$10 to \$60. And \$15 to \$70. This is due to costs of food. They are looking to have on water activities on Sunday thru Tuesday. Many captains do not wish to unplug for activities. It is hoped this will help with participation. It is very hard to get tally completed. Moving kids fishing and Geoquest to Saturday with the jr Power seminar on Thursday. On water activities for Jr will be held on Friday. This will allow time to get scholarship paperwork completed. All boats must be gone by 3 pm. Longer stays will be charged additional fees. Additional security will be hired for A and C docks for the evenings. There will be additional costs for this security. Still will need volunteer security from clubs.

Sail Yacht Appeals: None to report
