




Many thanks to Anita, Todd, and Jane for helping me through the awards handout and to Helena and Mike Soltis for taking pictures of all the winning crews.

MY WINTER PLANS: I usually do most of my boat maintenance at the start of the season, but this year I am


ahead of schedule thanks to a worn out water pump! All replaced and tested out. Ready for another 30 years of service!

IMPORTANT HEADS UP FROM DOUG ON CANADIAN CUSTOMS: "If one does not properly check into Canadian Customs, you can be subjected to a fine of not less than \$1,000."

DO YOU HAVE YOUR DTOPS DECAL? Boats of length 30' or more need a DTOPS decal to return to the U.S. This number as well as a Trusted Traveler number (may not be required for boaters) should be entered into CBP Roam as well as passport numbers.



CBP ROAM REQUIRED: US requires the use of CBP Roam. FOR MORE INFORMATION or to sign-up go to: https://ttp.cbp.dhs.gov/ (Official Trusted Traveler Program Website | Department of Homeland Security (dhs.gov))







