




Speaking of BOTY, don't forget the application deadline for 2024 award is January 31st, 2025 to be considered.







IMPORTANT HEADS UP FROM DOUG ON CANADIAN CUSTOMS: "If one does not properly check into Canadian Customs, you can be subjected to a fine of not less than \$1,000."

DO YOU HAVE YOUR DTOPS DECAL? Boats of length 30' or more need a DTOPS decal to return to the U.S. This number as well as a Trusted Traveler number (may not be required for boaters) should be entered into CBP Roam as well as passport numbers.

CBP ROAM REQUIRED: US requires the use of CBP Roam. FOR MORE INFORMATION or to sign-up go to: https://

Also, for more extensive travel, Nexus is the least expensive method. The current cost is \$120 valid for 5 years.






